June Block of the Month Grandmom's Favorite

Cutting instructions:

Color A (Pictured as purple):

(8) $2 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares

Color B (Pictured as green):

(4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square

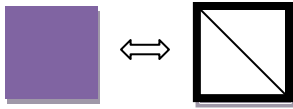
Color C (Background):

(8) $2 \frac{7}{8}$ inch squares

(5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

Half-square triangle construction:

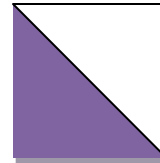
Using (8) Color A $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch (light purple) squares and (8) Color C $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares, draw a diagonal line on the back of the lighter fabric.



Place right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch on either side of the drawn line.

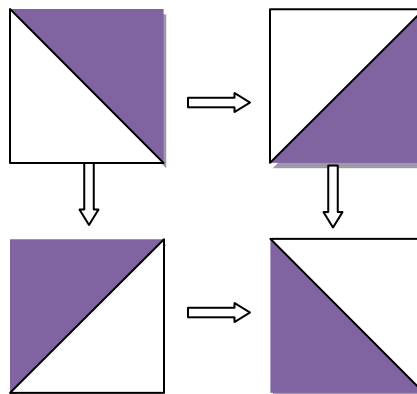


Cut on the drawn line and press towards the dark fabric. You will have eight half-square triangles.

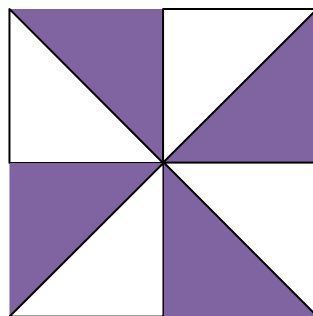


Assemble Pinwheels:

Using four half-square triangles arrange according the diagram:



Make four pinwheels:



Final assembly:
