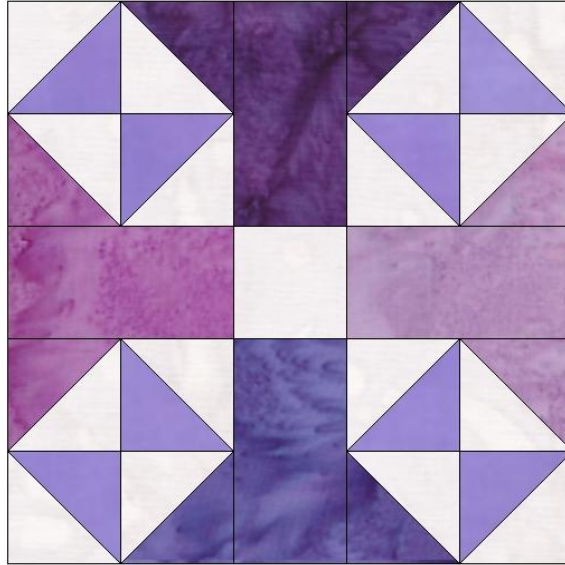


Quilty Delights

August Block of the Month Red Cross



Cutting instructions:

Color A (Pictured as purple):

(4) 2 ½ inch by 4 ½ inch rectangles (one from four different purple fabrics)

(4) 2 ⅞ inch squares (one from the same four different purples as the rectangles)

(4) 2 ⅞ inch squares (a fifth purple!)

Color C (Background):

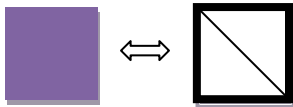
(1) 2 1/2 inch square

(8) 2 ⅞ inch squares

Block construction:

Half-square triangle construction:

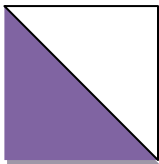
Using (4) Color A $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch (four different purple) squares and (4) Color C $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares, draw a diagonal line on the back of the lighter fabric.



Place right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ inch on either side of the drawn line.



Cut on the drawn line and press towards the dark fabric. You will have eight half-square triangles—keep the purples together.



Using the (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares of the fifth purple and the (4) $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch squares of Color C and make (8) half-square triangles, following the technique above.

Assembling the Block:

Orient the units according to the following diagram:
